

Failed to download package files error

The reason for this error is that Update Manager is using a server which doesn't have that specific package version.

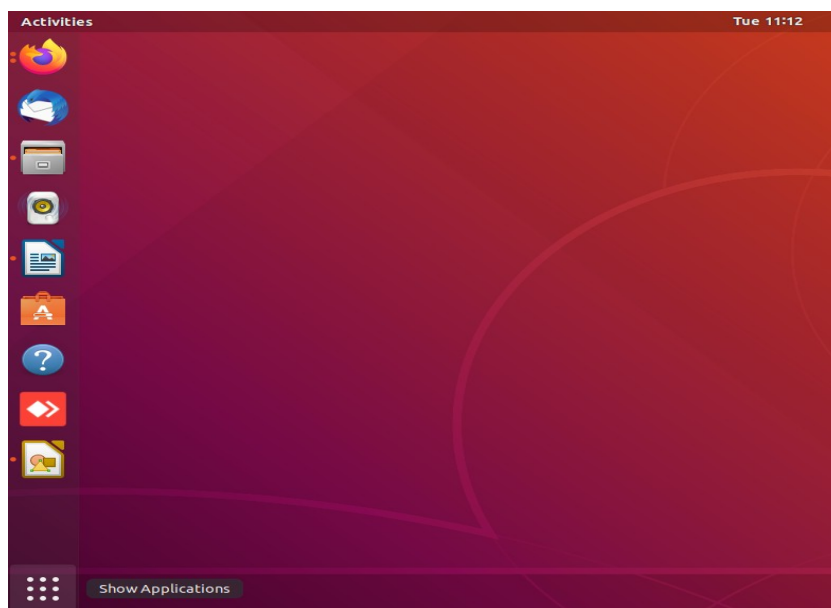
When you install Ubuntu or any other Linux OS, the software sources are set by default to the server mirror near your location.

This is to ensure that software downloads (and updates) are at good speed.

But it could happen that the server your system is using, has not been updated from the main server yet.

Step 1

Click on **Show Application** icon located at the down left corner of the screen



Step 2:

Now in the search bar type **Software update** and Press **Enter**

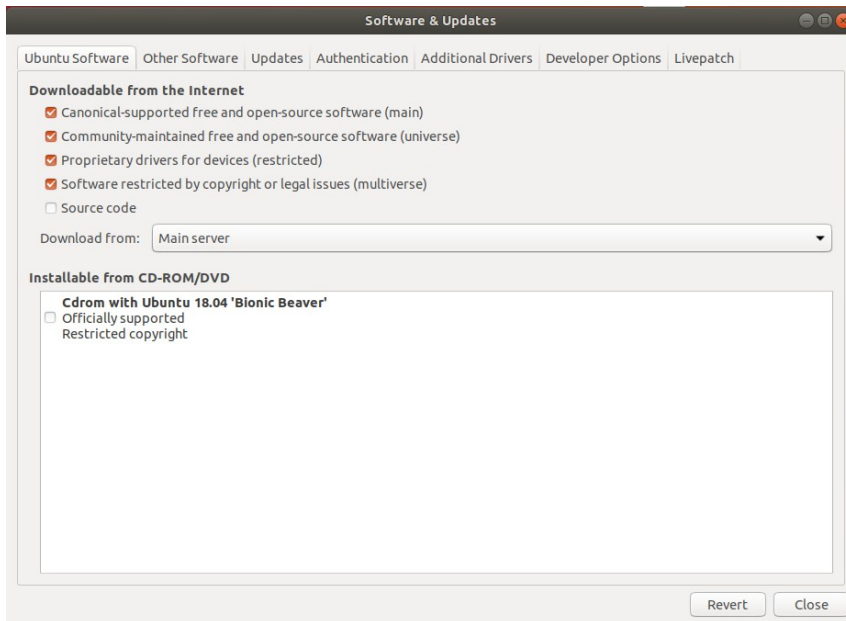


Step 3

Now **Software & Updates** dialog box will open

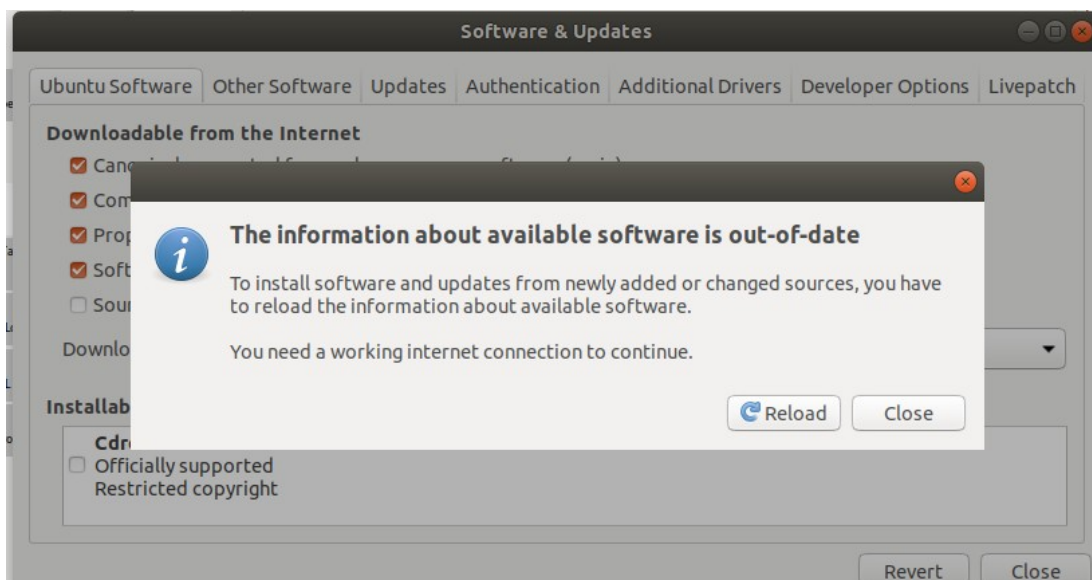
Under **Ubuntu Software** tab, go to the **Download from** option

Click on the drop down icon and change server to **Main server**.



Step 4

Now click on the **Close** button. A pop up will appear saying **The information about available software is out-of-date**. Click on **Reload** button

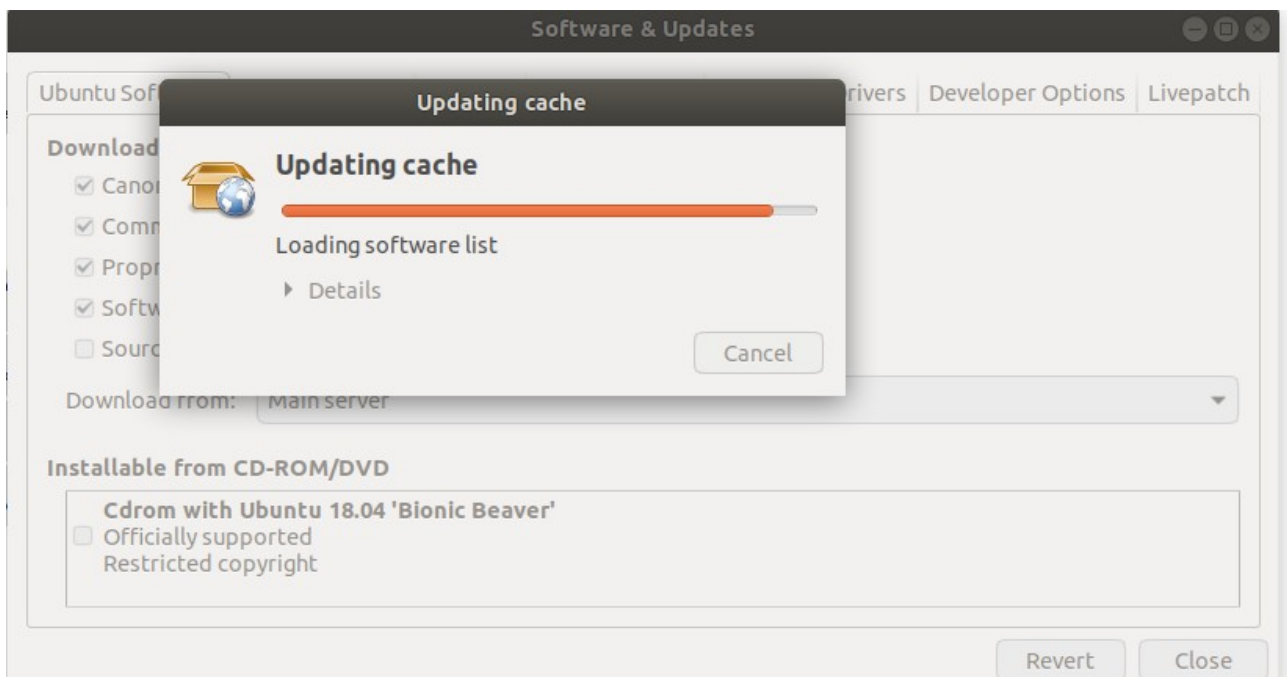


Step 5

It will update the software cache.

Run the Update Manager again.

The update should work just fine now.

Once done open terminal by pressing Ctrl+Alt+T keys together and type **sudo apt install fonts-lohit-deva** in terminal and enter password if prompted.

Now packages will get downloaded
