



## 1 Online / Offline content

1. The online content of Spoken Tutorials can be accessed from :  
<http://spoken-tutorial.org/tutorial-search/>
2. You can also download the Spoken Tutorials for offline learning from :  
<https://spoken-tutorial.org/cdcontent/>
  - (a) From this link download the **FOSS** categories in the **language** you wish to learn.
  - (b) The Spoken Tutorial content will be downloaded as a zip file on your machine.
  - (c) Right-click and extract the contents of the file to your **Desktop** folder.
  - (d) A folder named **spoken** will be extracted.
  - (e) Locate and double-click to open the **spoken** on the desktop.
  - (f) Locate **index.html** file; right-click on this file and open with **Firefox** or **Chrome** web-browser. Do NOT use **Internet Explorer** - some versions of it do not work properly with Spoken Tutorials.
  - (g) On the opening page you will have the following 3 tutorials:
    - i. **Side-by-Side Method** - it explains the method you should follow to practise along with Spoken Tutorials. Following this method reduces your cognitive overload, especially useful for beginners.
    - ii. **Spoken Tutorial Forums** - it explains the forum that will help get answers to your questions.
    - iii. **Spoken Tutorial Supplementary Material** - an important accompaniment of Spoken Tutorials is the additional materials that we provide in the code file section. Whenever they are available, you should make a copy of them and use them, as opposed to typing them from scratch.

## 2 The procedure to practise

1. You have been given a set of spoken tutorials and files.

2. You will typically do one tutorial at a time.
3. You may listen to a spoken tutorial and practise by reproducing all the steps shown in the tutorial Side-by-Side Method on <https://spoken-tutorial.org>.
4. If you find it difficult to do the above, you may consider listening to the whole tutorial once and then practise during the second hearing.
5. Once the tutorial is complete, choose the next tutorial from the playlist which is located on the right side or below the player.

## 3 Koha Library Software

1. At the top of the screen, click on **Select Foss Category** drop-down and choose **Koha Library Software**.
2. Click on **Select Language** drop-down and choose the language in which you wish to learn, from the available languages.
3. Click on the **Submit** button.
4. You will see a list of tutorials based on your selection.
5. Start with the first tutorial in the displayed list.

## 4 For System Administrators only and not for Librarians

Please note: Koha will not work on Windows OS.

3. At the end of this tutorial, you would have successfully installed Koha on your system.

## 4.2 Second Tutorial: Koha Web Installation and Onboarding

1. Watch and practise the tutorial: **Koha Web Installation and Onboarding**.
2. Replicate all the steps as demonstrated in the tutorial.
3. Create all the login credentials exactly as demonstrated in the tutorial.
4. At the end of this tutorial, you would have successfully Koha.
5. Share the login credentials and the onboarding details with the Librarian.

## 5 For Librarians

1. Watch and practise the the tutorials starting from: **Add a New Library**.
2. Your System Administrator would have already installed Koha for you.
3. Get the login credentials and onboarding details from your System Administrator before you proceed.
4. Please note: Login credentials used in the tutorials are as follows:
  - (a) Web interface:  
User: koha\_library **Password: koha123**
  - (b) Superlibrarian:  
User: Bella **Password: Library@1**
  - (c) Staff Login:  
User: Vaibhavi **Password: Vaibhavi02**
  - (d) Patron Login :  
User: Maya **Password: Maya@123**

### 5.1 Instructions to practise

1. To watch, locate the topic and click on it.
2. To view the tutorial, click on the Play icon which is located in the player.

3. Adjust the size of the browser in such a way that you are able to practice in parallel.
4. Play-pause-practise the whole tutorial.
5. Reproduce all the commands exactly as shown in the tutorials.
6. Make a note of login details (username and password) for all the Patrons that you create.
7. The Pre-requisite will be visible below the player (only for Online contents).
8. Outline, Assignment and Code Files are available below the player.
9. Once the tutorial is complete, choose the next tutorial from the playlist which is located on the right side or below the player.
10. Follow all the above instructions, till you complete all the tutorials in the series.
